The goal of the CEAS program is to rapidly facilitate business recovery activities in an impacted area by providing quick access to affected work-sites by critical organization employees once the areas have been designated as safe. CEAS allows organizations to assess damage, maintain core IT systems, meet regulatory obligations, and secure or remove critical records and data.

**We will have representation from the City of Boston Mayor's Office as well as the Boston and Cambridge Police Departments and the Cambridge Fire Department.**

In addition to Boston and Cambridge, CEAS programs have already been implemented in multiple cities such as New York City and surrounding counties, Buffalo, Stamford, Philadelphia and Baltimore. More cities nationwide are expected to participate in the near future.
