

## **ASIS Boston Chapter**

### **Security Officer of the Year Award**

#### **Criteria:**

The Security Officer of the Year Award presented by the ASIS Boston Chapter is designed to recognize the outstanding achievement and professionalism of a security officer. The award recognizes an act of bravery, courage, competence and selflessness of a security officer who went above and beyond the call of duty to protect people and/or property.

Nominees are not required to be a member of ASIS and may be contract or proprietary security officers. The nominee must have been employed within the Boston Chapter's general geographic region (Eastern MA) during the act.

#### **Conditions:**

The nominated Security Officer must have performed an act(s) of merit or heroism leading to the saving of life or property or leading to the arrest or apprehension of a perpetrator of a crime while on duty. The officer may also have performed in a superior manner in the course of his or her duties and, in doing so, has far exceeded the expectations of their position and training.

The act(s) should have taken place between September 1, 2012 and September 1, 2013. All nominations must be made by the nominated Security Officer's superior and submitted on company letterhead.

#### **Award**

The officer who is selected to win the award will be presented with a plaque (or similar award) and a monetary award at the ASIS Boston Chapter Awards Dinner on 11/14/13. The Chapter Awards Committee will select the winner of the Award in consultation with the Chapter Board. The winner will be notified no later than 10/31/13. All decisions are final.

#### **Deadline for Submissions:**

The deadline for submissions is October 15, 2013.

**Nominations:**

Must include the following:

- That you are nominating the officer for “Security Officer of the Year”
- Name of company
- Full name and age of nominee
- Title and position of nominee
- Length of service
- All relevant details pertaining to the incident(s).
- If available/feasible, the nomination should include any supporting documentation such as internal incident reports, newspaper articles, administrative reports, statements or unsolicited letters from unbiased witnesses, and copies or external agency reports, i.e., law enforcement, fire and/or emergency medical service agencies.
- Signature and title of the person making the nomination
